## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Atlanta Community Food Bank on the occasion of its 35th

2 anniversary and for its contributions to the people of the State of Georgia; and for other

- 3 purposes.
- WHEREAS, the Atlanta Community Food Bank was founded in 1979 by Bill Bolling in the
  basement of St. Luke's Episcopal Church; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Community Food Bank serves 58,900 people, who are now
  7 receiving emergency food each week through a network of more than 600 nonprofit partner
  8 agencies; and
- 9 WHEREAS, 94 cents of every dollar donated to the Atlanta Community Food Bank go10 directly to services in the community to help fight hunger; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Community Food Bank provided 72 percent of the food distributed
- 12 by partner food panties, 47 percent of the food served at partner soup kitchens, and 31
- 13 percent of the food served at partner shelters in 2009; and
- 14 WHEREAS, it was able to distribute \$9.21 worth of grocery products back into the15 community for every \$1.00 donated; and
- WHEREAS, the Atlanta Community Food Bank's volunteers served 106,418 hours in
  support of the Atlanta Community Food Bank's mission in fiscal year 2012-2013, the
  equivalent of hours served by 52 full-time staff members; and
- WHEREAS, it is one of more than 200 food banks that are members of Feeding America,the nation's largest domestic hunger-relief organization; and

- 21 WHEREAS, the mission of the Atlanta Community Food Bank is to fight hunger by
- 22 engaging and educating and empowering our community; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Community Food Bank also operates seven projects that enhance
- 24 its mission: Atlanta Prosperity Campaign, Atlanta's Table, Community Gardens, Hunger 101,
- 25 Hunger Walk/Run, Kids In Need, and Product Rescue Center.
- 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 27 the members of this body recognize and commend the Atlanta Community Food Bank on the
- 28 occasion of its 35th anniversary and for its volunteering services and contributions to the
- 29 people of the State of Georgia.
- 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 31 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Atlanta Community
- 32 Food Bank.
