

The Senate Health and Human Services Committee offered the following substitute to SB 358:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 4 of Chapter 3 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
2 relating to the Missing Children Information Center, so as to provide for missing child  
3 reports for foster children; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for  
4 other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

**SECTION 1.**

6 Article 4 of Chapter 3 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the  
7 Missing Children Information Center, is amended by revising Code Section 35-3-83, relating  
8 to missing child reports, as follows:

10 "35-3-83.

11 Upon the filing of a police report by the parent, ~~or guardian, caretaker, governmental unit~~  
12 responsible for the child, or other person with legal custody of the child that a child is  
13 missing, the local law enforcement agency receiving such report shall notify all of its  
14 on-duty law enforcement officers of the existence of the missing child report, communicate  
15 the report to all other law enforcement agencies having jurisdiction in the county and all  
16 law enforcement agencies of jurisdictions geographically adjoining that of the local law  
17 enforcement agency, and transmit the report to the Missing Children Information Center."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
