A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Tuesday, February 25, 2014, as Business Cyber Security Day at the state
2 capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, cyber security is a prerequisite for this state's business prosperity and financial
4 growth in this century; and

5 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is committed to providing an environment that fosters trust
6 and confidence for all citizens and businesses; and

7 WHEREAS, the Technology Association of Georgia, the Georgia Department of Defense,
8 the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, Cobb County
9 9-1-1, Cobb County Police, and Cyber Exercises will conduct the open 2014 Cyber Security
10 Simulation at Clay National Guard Center to build cooperation and government-enterprise
11 partnership and prepare Georgia businesses to react quickly and with minimum damage to
12 the inevitable cyber challenges that lie ahead; and

13 WHEREAS, numerous private citizens, organizations, enterprises, affiliated organizations,
14 sponsors, C-level executives, senior managers, and practitioners from several different areas
15 of business will cooperate in the delivery of the simulation, dissemination, and
16 implementation of the lessons learned.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 recognize Tuesday, February 25, 2014, as Business Cyber Security Day at the state capitol
19 and encourage all participants in the business ecosystem of the State of Georgia to perform
20 their duty in sharing their time, experiences, knowledge, and insights for the common cyber
21 security of all organizations operating in this state.
