## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to revenue and
- 2 taxation, so as to repeal Chapter 12, relating to estate tax, and enact a new Chapter 12; to
- 3 prohibit the levy or collection of estate taxes; to provide for applicability; to provide that this
- 4 Act shall not abate or affect prosecutions, punishments, penalties, administrative proceedings
- 5 or remedies, or civil actions related to certain violations; to provide an effective date; to
- 6 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to revenue and taxation, is
- amended by repealing in its entirety Chapter 12, relating to estate tax, and enacting a new
- 11 Chapter 12 to read as follows:
- 12 "<u>CHAPTER 12</u>
- 13 <u>48-12-1.</u>
- 14 (a) On and after July 1, 2014, there shall be no estate taxes levied by the state and no estate
- 15 <u>tax returns shall be required.</u>
- 16 (b) Tax, penalty, and interest liabilities and refund eligibility for prior taxable years shall
- 17 <u>not be affected by the enactment of this Code section and shall continue to be governed by</u>
- the provisions of general law as it existed immediately prior to July 1, 2014.
- 19 (c) This Code section shall not abate any prosecution, punishment, penalty, administrative
- 20 proceeding or remedy, or civil action related to any violation of law committed prior to
- 21 <u>July 1, 2014.</u>"

- 23 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
