

## House Resolution 1588

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Wednesday, February 26, 2014, as White County Day at the state capitol; and  
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, White County, Georgia, was founded in 1857 and named for David White, a  
4 legislator from Newton County who helped pass the bill that created White County; and

5 WHEREAS, White covers 242 square miles and has a population of over 27,000; and

6 WHEREAS, White County encompasses most of the headwater streams of the  
7 Chattahoochee River and is thus a major source of Atlanta's water supply; and

8 WHEREAS, White County is known as the gateway to Georgia's mountains and is home to  
9 many ecological tourist attractions, such as the Chattahoochee National Forest, through  
10 which the Appalachian Trail runs, and Unicoi State Park, Smithgall Woods Conservation  
11 Area, and the Sautee Nacoochee Community Association in Nacoochee Valley; and

12 WHEREAS, White County is also home to tourist attractions, including Babyland General  
13 Hospital, the whimsical birthplace of the dolls known as Cabbage Patch Kids, as well as  
14 Helen, a look-alike Bavarian village that has become one of the largest tourist attractions in  
15 Georgia and the site of one of the nation's largest Oktoberfest celebrations; and

16 WHEREAS, the White County Chamber of Commerce is working to develop and apply new  
17 ideas, techniques, and technologies to generate and improve productivity levels, fiscal  
18 sustainability, business development, job growth, and quality of life within White County;  
19 and

20 WHEREAS, the citizens of White County are justly proud of their community, its past, and  
21 its many contributions to the state, and it is only fitting and proper to recognize this  
22 magnificent county.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
24 the members of this body recognize Wednesday, February 26, 2014, as White County Day  
25 at the state capitol and express their sincerest best wishes of continued success.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
27 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the White County Chamber  
28 of Commerce.
