A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Georgia school workers; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, school workers across the State of Georgia were indispensable to the children
3 of this state in the days following the 2014 winter storms, which caused more than \$25
4 million in damage; and

5 WHEREAS, within hours after the first storm hit, Georgia school workers worked with local
6 officials to provide safe harbor for many children in our school systems; and

7 WHEREAS, while the magnitude of the ice storms made recovery efforts more difficult and
8 slower in some areas than was hoped, countless school workers went above and beyond the
9 call of duty to ensure that Georgians were kept safe; and

10 WHEREAS, the work of local and state officials, utility workers, volunteers, members of the
11 Georgia National Guard, and all those who contributed to the recovery and relief efforts
12 following the storms should be commended; and

13 WHEREAS, throughout a difficult and hazardous situation, Georgia school workers stood
14 strong for the children of Georgia.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 commend Georgia school workers for their exceptional efforts in our great state following
17 the 2014 winter storms.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
19 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the public and the press.
