A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 50-36-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 requirements, procedures, and conditions for verification of lawful presence within the
- 3 United States, exceptions, regulations, and criminal and other penalties for violations, so as
- 4 to change certain provisions relating to such verification of lawful presence in conjunction
- 5 with the electronic filing of an application for a license, certificate, permit, or registration,
- 6 or renewal thereof, issued by a professional licensing board; to provide for related matters;
- 7 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 Code Section 50-36-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to requirements,
- 11 procedures, and conditions for verification of lawful presence within the United States,
- 12 exceptions, regulations, and criminal and other penalties for violations, is amended by adding
- a new paragraph to subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 14 "(5) A professional licensing board through the office of the director of the professional
- 15 <u>licensing boards division within the office of the Secretary of State may provide an</u>
- alternative method for any applicant filing electronically for a license, certificate, permit,
- or registration, or renewal thereof, to satisfy the requirements of paragraphs (1) and (3)
- of this subsection. Such method shall require the applicant to provide a verifiable driver's
- license number or identification card number issued by this state on or after July 1, 2012,
- which complies with requirements of paragraph (1) of subsection (g) of this Code section.
- 21 <u>If a professional licensing board makes such a method available, the applicant's name and</u>
- 22 <u>the number of such driver's license or identification card provided shall be verified with</u>
- 23 <u>the Department of Driver Services, unless the applicant is exempted under paragraph (4)</u>
- 24 <u>of this subsection.</u>"
