A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Georgia Asian American Pacific Islander's Task Force; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Asian American Pacific Islander community represents a large segment of
- 3 the population of the State of Georgia and contributes significantly to the economic
- 4 well-being and cultural richness of this state; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Asian American Pacific Islanders are one of the fastest growing groups in
- 6 Georgia and the United States; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Georgia is committed to understanding the community, economic, social,
- 8 health, and educational needs and issues that are important to the Asian American Pacific
- 9 Islander population in this state; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Georgia is interested in advancing the role that Asian American Pacific
- 11 Islanders play in the governance of this state at local, state, and federal levels.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- there is created the Georgia Asian American Pacific Islander's Task Force to consist of 12
- 14 members to be appointed as follows: two members shall be appointed by the Governor,
- selected from among the citizens of Georgia; one member shall be appointed by the Speaker
- of the House of Representatives; one member shall be appointed by the Speaker Pro Tempore
- of the House of Representatives; one member shall be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor;
- one member shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; one member
- shall be appointed by the minority leader of the Senate; one member shall be appointed by
- 20 the minority leader of the House of Representatives; one member shall be appointed by the
- 21 Attorney General; one member shall be appointed by the Commissioner of Labor; one
- 22 member shall be appointed by the Secretary of State; and one member shall be appointed by
- 23 the commissioner of economic development. All members shall be selected from a list of
- 24 nominees submitted by interested parties, national ethnic groups, and organizations or

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25 associations representing various nationalities. All public members shall be appointed for

- 26 a term of two years and shall serve without compensation. The chairperson of the task force
- shall be selected by the membership of the task force. For administrative purposes, the task
- 28 force shall be coordinated and staffed by the Department of Economic Development.
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall include among its powers and
- 30 responsibilities the following:
- 31 (1) Developing and coordinating state-wide programs to recognize and maximize the
- 32 continuing contributions of Asian American Pacific Islanders in Georgia;
- 33 (2) Drawing upon the membership's shared knowledge and expertise in creating activities
- designed to educate all citizens of Georgia regarding Asian American Pacific Islander
- issues and culture and to promote the community by celebrating the great religious, ethnic,
- and racial diversity within this state;
- 37 (3) Developing policies to improve the economic, social, health, and educational needs
- important to the Asian American Pacific Islander community in Georgia;
- 39 (4) Increasing awareness among Asian American Pacific Islanders regarding governmental
- 40 affairs and community and social service resources that may benefit Asian American
- 41 Pacific Islander individuals and the community as a whole; and
- 42 (5) Meeting no less than quarterly and providing an annual report to the Governor and the
- 43 legislature of its findings, outlining its progress and offering the task force's
- recommendations as they relate to the charge and duties set forth above.
- 45 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall report its findings and
- 46 recommendations to the Governor and the legislature on January 1 of each year.
