## AS PASSED SENATE

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 4 of Chapter 3 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the Missing Children Information Center, so as to provide for missing child
- 3 reports for foster children; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 4 other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 4 of Chapter 3 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 8 Missing Children Information Center, is amended by revising Code Section 35-3-83, relating
- 9 to missing child reports, as follows:
- 10 "35-3-83.
- Upon the filing of a police report by the parent, or guardian, caretaker, governmental unit
- responsible for the child, or other person with legal custody of the child that a child is
- missing, the local law enforcement agency receiving such report shall notify all of its
- on-duty law enforcement officers of the existence of the missing child report, communicate
- the report to all other law enforcement agencies having jurisdiction in the county and all
- law enforcement agencies of jurisdictions geographically adjoining that of the local law
- enforcement agency, and transmit the report to the Missing Children Information Center."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
