A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of David Wilson Caraway; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its distinguished citizens with the
3 passing of David Wilson Caraway on February 14, 2014; and

4 WHEREAS, David Wilson Caraway was born in Columbus, Georgia and was a lifetime
5 resident and civic contributor to the City of Columbus; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Caraway was a graduate of Columbus High School and Auburn University,
7 becoming a Certified Public Account who successfully operated his small business for years;

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Caraway was a committed and invaluable member of his community
10 including active involvement in Toastmaster International serving as District Governor, as
11 a member of Muscogee Rotary Club and as a member of the Muscogee Lion Club; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Caraway was a lifelong faithful Christian and member of Rose Hill Baptist
13 Church, Edgewood Baptist Church and First Baptist Church of Columbus; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Caraway was also a loving and caring husband and father to his wife of
15 fifty years, Barbara Hackett Caraway, his two daughters, Susan and Sharon, and was devoted
16 to his siblings and other family members.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 join in honoring the life and memory of David Wilson Caraway and express their deepest and
19 most sincere regret at his passing.
