A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending The Kennickell Group and Trip Kennickell; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in 1892, Milton Kennickell opened a small print shop in downtown Savannah;
4 by 1950, Kennickell Printing had grown from being one of the smallest printers in town to
5 the largest; and

6 WHEREAS, The Kennickell Group has earned significant recognition and awards over the
7 years for its excellence in printing and was the first printing company in the United States
8 to receive ISO 9000 Certification awarded by the International Organization of
9 Standardization; and

10 WHEREAS, this family owned enterprise has been a leader in the print industry for more
11 than a century and has developed many award-winning marketing strategies; and

12 WHEREAS, The Kennickell Group, as part of its rich history of service in Georgia, seeks
13 to benefit members of the General Assembly by printing 500 copies of the Capitol
14 Commission Bible Studies, at its own personal expense, which are hand-delivered to each
15 legislative office and made available to several other offices that comprise the capitol
16 community; and

17 WHEREAS, the Capitol Commission Bible Studies are a blessing to the capitol community
18 and a spiritual resource for members of the General Assembly.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend The Kennickell Group for its service to the Savannah community and for
21 providing the Capitol Commission Bible Studies to the General Assembly, and thus for its

23 their sincere thanks and best wishes for continued success.
