1 Recognizing and commending Carol Megathlin; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Carol Megathlin has been awarded the Outstanding Civilian Service Medal by
3 the Department of the Army for her exemplary public service from September 2002 to
4 January 2014; and

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Megathlin demonstrated great care for deployed soldiers by funding the
6 Adopt-a-Soldier Program for the 3d Infantry Division of Fort Stewart, Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, this program connects Americans with soldiers, who may not have a support
8 network during their deployment, to provide letters of support, emails, and care packages;

10 WHEREAS, additionally, her service on the Board of Directors for the Honor Flight
11 Savannah, Inc., enabled 226 veterans to visit memorials built and dedicated to honor their
12 sacrifices in past wars; and

13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Megathlin's extraordinary service and great concern for our soldiers and
14 veterans show true patriotism and reflect great credit upon herself, the 3d Infantry Division,
15 the XVIII Airborne Corps and Fort Bragg, and the United States Army; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
17 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body recognize and commend Carol Megathlin for her passionate
20 dedication to this nation's soldiers and veterans and express to her their most sincere best
21 wishes for continued success.
