17 WHEREAS, she is an active member of Zion Hill Baptist Church and serves on the senior
18 ushers ministry, courtesy guild, and missionary ministry; and

19 WHEREAS, Delores is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable
20 reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

21 WHEREAS, Women's History Month, March, 2014, is set aside to celebrate and honor these
22 women who have contributed their time and talents to the betterment of this state and nation,
23 and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
24 remarkable Georgian be appropriately recognized.
