## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Frank Wood; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Frank Wood recently helped corral and capture an immature bald eagle that had  
3 become entangled in discarded fishing line on Blue Ridge Lake and was unable to fly; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Wood and others were able to turn this eagle over to a ranger of the  
5 Department of Natural Resources, who arranged to have the bird transported to Auburn  
6 University, where the bird is now recuperating in preparation for return to the wild; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Wood, through his successful efforts to rescue this specimen of our national  
8 symbol, demonstrated exemplary citizenship; and

9 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that he be recognized by this body.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
11 the members of this body commend Frank Wood for his efforts in rescuing a bald eagle,  
12 symbol of our nation, and express to him their most sincere gratitude for this civic action.

14 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Frank Wood.
