A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Christopher A. Rogers; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Christopher A. Rogers of Troop 580 has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the
3 most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
8 Christopher has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the various
9 special skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Christopher's Eagle Scout service project was completed at Lucerne Baptist
11 Church in Lilburn, Georgia; he led a group of scouts and other volunteers in building a 16'
12 x 20' deck, stone fire pit, and wood rack for the church youth and home school group to use
13 for efficiently and neatly storing lumber on the deck itself; and
- 14 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
15 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
16 becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in a world which consistently seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the
18 actions of young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with
19 particularity the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that Christopher A. Rogers
21 is commended for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the
22 Boy Scouts of America and congratulated on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
