3 Delegation from February, 2004, through August, 2012; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital role that
5 he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens
6 of Georgia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, a native of Bowling Green, Kentucky, Kip studied political science at Shepherd
8 University and public relations at Western Kentucky University; and
- 9 WHEREAS, during his nine sessions of service with the Fulton County House Delegation,
10 Kip successfully managed the day-to-day operations of the delegation and assisted in the
11 processing of local legislation for Fulton County and its 14 cities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Kip's significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
13 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this
14 state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he is an active member of the Buckhead Church and is involved with the
16 congregation's singles ministry; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Kip also dedicates his time to his community, serving as past president of both
18 the Historic College Park Neighborhood Association and the College Park Historical Society,
19 and was designated a Kentucky Colonel in 2005; and
- 20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
21 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
