## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Teen Republicans; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Teen Republicans traces its roots to the late 1970s, when the first clubs were  
3 organized in Georgia with Speaker Newt Gingrich as an early sponsor of the movement, and  
4 the organization thrived throughout the Reagan Revolution of the 1980s; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in 1991, John Bradberry of North Fulton County was elected as state  
6 chairperson and the organization came under the direct sponsorship of the Georgia  
7 Republican Party, and Senate President Pro Tempore David Shafer, then executive director  
8 of the Georgia Republican Party, served as state advisor; and
- 9 WHEREAS, last year the Teen Republicans state convention was convened in the Senate  
10 chamber for the fourth year in a row, and Michael Strollo of Johns Creek was elected state  
11 chairperson and Mr. Melvin Everson was appointed state advisor; and
- 12 WHEREAS, speakers included former Congressman Bob Barr and State Representative  
13 Michael Caldwell, and the Teen Republicans is thriving and continuously growing stronger  
14 in Georgia, teaching students about the United States Constitution and conservative values.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
16 commend the Teen Republicans for its many contributions and successes.
