## A RESOLUTION

7 and Milton L. Fleetwood serving as secretary-treasurer; and

9 develop service opportunities; establish and maintain high ethical standards in business and  
10 professions; apply the ideals of service in the personal and professional lives of members;

21 organization and its numerous contributions to the citizens of this state be appropriately  
22 recognized.

25 Rotary Club and congratulate its members on the occasion of its 90th anniversary.
