23 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Uhlich has served with honor and distinction on behalf of the public health
25 field, and his vision and unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the occasion of

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
28 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
