## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending The Links, Incorporated, and recognizing March 21, 2014, as Links Day at the  
2 state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, The Links, Incorporated, is a nonprofit organization composed of more than  
4 12,000 women of African heritage living in the United States and abroad who are committed  
5 to devoting their talents and resources to improving the quality of life for others; and

6 WHEREAS, founded in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in 1946, The Links, Incorporated, has  
7 276 chapters nation-wide with 15 chapters in Georgia, representing 600 members in every  
8 major city; and

9 WHEREAS, on March 21, 2014, members of The Links, Incorporated, across the country  
10 will gather at their state capitols to encourage support for legislation and programs designed  
11 to address the growing epidemic of childhood obesity and its causes; and

12 WHEREAS, the outstanding service The Links, Incorporated, provides to local communities  
13 and throughout the nation is worthy of recognition.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
15 the members of this body commend The Links, Incorporated, for its work to improve the  
16 quality of life in this state and nation and recognize March 21, 2014, as Links Day at the state  
17 capitol.
