## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 10A of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 professional counselors, social workers, and marriage and family therapists, so as to revise
- 3 definitions relating to marriage and family therapy; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 10A of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to professional
- 8 counselors, social workers, and marriage and family therapists, is amended in Code Section
- 9 43-10A-3, relating to definitions, by revising paragraphs (8) and (17) as follows:
- 10 "(8) 'Marriage and family therapy' means that specialty which evaluates, diagnoses, and
- treats emotional and mental problems and conditions, whether cognitive, affective, or
- behavioral, resolves intrapersonal and interpersonal conflicts, and changes perception,
- attitudes, and behavior; all within the context of marital and family systems. Marriage
- and family therapy includes, without being limited to, individual, group, couple, sexual,
- family, and divorce therapy. Marriage and family therapy involves an applied
- understanding of the dynamics of marital and family systems, including individual
- psychodynamics, the use of assessment instruments that evaluate marital and family
- functioning, designing and recommending a course of treatment, and the use of
- 19 psychotherapy and counseling."
- 20 "(17) 'The Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy Education'
- 21 means the national accrediting agency for marriage and family therapy education as
- recognized by the United States Department of Education Council for Higher Education
- 23 <u>Accreditation.</u>"

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
