A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Savannah River Caucus of the South Carolina Legislature;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Savannah River Caucus of the Georgia General Assembly and the Savannah
4 River Caucus of the South Carolina Legislature were formed in 2013; and

5 WHEREAS, the two caucuses have met together since their formation to promote the mutual
6 interests and find solutions for the common problems of the areas surrounding the Savannah
7 River; and

8 WHEREAS, the Savannah River and the areas surrounding it constitute a tremendous
9 resource to both the State of Georgia and the State of South Carolina; and

10 WHEREAS, the establishment of the Savannah River Caucus in both legislatures is an
11 excellent way to meet and discuss the needs of the region and how best to meet those needs;

13 WHEREAS, the members of the Savannah River Caucus of the South Carolina Legislature
14 have extended hospitality to the members of the Savannah River Caucus of the Georgia
15 General Assembly, and the members of this body would like to express their appreciation for
16 that hospitality and the work of the Savannah River Caucus of the South Carolina
17 Legislature; and

18 WHEREAS, the members of the Savannah River Caucus of the South Carolina Legislature
19 show a deep commitment to providing superior representation to their community and
20 demonstrate their concern for the citizens of the Savannah River area through their efforts,
21 setting an example as leaders of their respective communities.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 recognize and commend the Savannah River Caucus of the South Carolina Legislature for
24 its many contributions to the improvement of the Savannah River area.
