A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Lori Myles in honor of Women's History Month 2014;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Lori Myles has worked as an educator at Thomas Walter Josey High School
4 for 28 years and as an adjunct professor at Aiken Technical College; and

5 WHEREAS, she is a graduate of Paine College and Georgia Southern University and has
6 earned a doctorate in administration, leadership, and supervision; and

7 WHEREAS, Dr. Myles has trained city leaders, executives, and their employees in
8 administrative motivational techniques in subject areas such as teamwork, leadership,
9 supervision, and effective management procedures; and

10 WHEREAS, she is currently an official candidate to become the first female mayor of the
11 City of Augusta-Richmond County in January, 2015; and

12 WHEREAS, Dr. Myles' expertise has led her to be the president and chief executive officer
13 of the National Coalition of 100 Black Women of America: Augusta Organizing Chapter;

15 WHEREAS, Dr. Myles sits on the board of the Georgia initiative to decrease teenage
16 pregnancy and the spread of HIV/AIDS in the Augusta community, and she is an advocate
17 for women in the areas of urban housing and development and bus transportation needs in
18 the Augusta area; and

19 WHEREAS, during her career, she has worked also as a journalist, reporter, weekend news
20 producer, and master control operator for WRDW TV-12; and

21 WHEREAS, Dr. Myles is united in love and marriage to Pastor Kerwin Myles and is blessed
22 with two remarkable children, Kelora and Chareva, and a wonderful grandson, Reginald; and

23 WHEREAS, her personal vision and mission in life is to allow God to use her to continue to
24 highlight and bring awareness to the social, political, and health issues concerning all
25 women; and

26 WHEREAS, Women's History Month, March, 2014, is set aside to celebrate and honor these
27 women who have contributed their time and talents to the betterment of this state and nation,
28 and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
29 remarkable Georgian be recognized.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
31 the members of this body recognize and commend Dr. Lori Myles in honor of Women's
32 History Month 2014 for her extraordinary dedication to protecting and improving the quality
