

## Senate Resolution 1191

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Richard Moore on the occasion of his retirement; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Richard Moore has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the  
4 vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare  
5 of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Moore worked as the managing director for external affairs with AGL  
7 Resources and is retiring after 45 years of faithful service; and

8 WHEREAS, his work at AGL Resources was focused on marketing, economic development,  
9 and government relations; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Moore serves as a working partner on Georgia Allies, a public-private  
11 partnership formed to help promote the State of Georgia's marketing efforts, and is a past  
12 chairman of the Georgia Chamber of Commerce's Red Carpet Tour; and

13 WHEREAS, he is a board member of the Development Authority of Cobb County, the  
14 Georgia Academy of Economic Development, and the Georgia Youth Science & Technology  
15 Centers; and

16 WHEREAS, in addition to his service in the economic development of Georgia, Mr. Moore  
17 has served his community and state by working on campaigns supporting the United Way,  
18 the American Red Cross, and the Boy Scouts of America; and

19 WHEREAS, he began as a "Sad Boy" from Brunswick, played college baseball with some  
20 of his life-long friends, and has always been willing to come to the aid of a damsel in distress  
21 or a friend in need; and

22 WHEREAS, an avid golf player, Mr. Moore has lost fewer company golf balls than any  
23 coworker with half his tenure, has cheated less in golf tournaments/political fund-raisers, and  
24 has celebrated more wins and losses at the "19th hole" than any other lobbyist of his era; and

25 WHEREAS, he is a "Golden Pigeon" of his own feather and is known as the "consigliere"  
26 to many young governmental affairs specialists; and

27 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience  
28 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this  
29 state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

30 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
31 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
33 commend Richard Moore for his efficient, effective, and dedicated service, congratulate him  
34 upon the grand occasion of his retirement, and extend to him their most sincere best wishes  
35 for continued health and happiness.
