A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 12, 2014, as the Council for Quality Growth Day at the state capitol; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Council for Quality Growth is a 29 year-old trade association representing
4 the growth and development industry with the mission of promoting balanced and
5 responsible growth in metro Atlanta and Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, the Council for Quality Growth brings the development community and policy
7 makers together as they focus on long-range community planning, encouraging adequate
8 government services, catalyzing consensus on growth issues, and convening discussion on
9 responsible development; and

10 WHEREAS, the Council for Quality Growth is a nonprofit trade association comprised of
11 a diverse membership of developers, contractors, engineers, architects, planners, law firms,
12 and bankers; anyone with an interest in growth and development; and

13 WHEREAS, the Council for Quality Growth delivers this mission through the platforms of
14 advocacy, education, and information by working with thousands of elected officials,
15 administrators, and professional staff across metro Atlanta's more than 80 local governments,
16 along with state agencies and legislative and executive leadership; and

17 WHEREAS, the Council for Quality Growth is committed to the mission of promoting
18 balanced and responsible growth and is proactively involved in the formulation of policy and
19 legislation critical to the growth and development industry by addressing, head-on, strategic
20 economic planning, infrastructure needs, and tough quality-of-life issues throughout the
21 metro Atlanta region and this state; and

22 WHEREAS, the Council for Quality Growth continues to grow in the metro region and
23 increase its influence among policy makers and elected officials state-wide; and

24 WHEREAS, the Council for Quality Growth will host its second annual "Council for Quality
25 Growth Day at the Capitol" on March 12, 2014, in order to bring awareness to the needs of
26 development officials to members of the Georgia General Assembly, and allow Council
27 members to interact with policymakers at the state level.

30 commend this group for their efforts in promoting economic growth in the State of Georgia.
