5	SECTION 1.
6	Chapter 3 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state flag, seal,
7	and other symbols, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:
8	"ARTICLE 5
9	<u>50-3-105.</u>
10	(a) There shall be placed upon the capitol grounds of the state capitol building or in
11	another prominent place a statue of the Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr., subject to the
12	availability of private funds for such purpose.
13	(b) Unless public safety concerns warrant postponement, such monument shall be procured
14	and placed as soon as practicable but not before the state has been granted any intellectual
15	property license necessary for purposes of this Code section."
16	SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
