A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 13, 2014, as District 35 Legislative Day at the capitol; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on March 13, 2014, elected officials from the state, county, and municipal
4 levels, along with the constituents they serve, will come together to declare and celebrate the
5 success and unique appeal of South Fulton and Douglas Counties of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, District 35, which includes sections of unincorporated Fulton County and
7 Douglas County and the cities of Southwest Atlanta, College Park, Union City, East Point,
8 Hapeville, Palmetto, Chattahoochee Hills, and Fairburn, is a vibrant, beautiful community
9 that is rich in natural resources and competitive business advantages; and

10 WHEREAS, the progressive governments of South Fulton County, Douglas County, and
11 Lithia Springs provide positive environments for business growth through efficient services
12 and effective collaboration with developers to create new employment opportunities; and

13 WHEREAS, District 35 legislators, commissioners, mayors, city councilmembers, and
14 citizens are committed to working together to continuously improve the quality of life,
15 education, employment opportunities, and faith in their diverse communities. They have
16 successfully established such initiatives as the Educational Wrap-around Collaborative,
17 which includes Parent University, Red Carpet Schools, and the South Fulton Incubator
18 Project; and

19 WHEREAS, with abundant resources and the commitment from all sectors of the community
20 to continue to work cooperatively for quality economic development, the future of increased
21 international business has never looked more promising; and
