8 and raised more than \$1,000 to support a sewing trade school for girls in Haiti; and

10 sewing materials, and school books to the Foundation Severe dhooti; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in recognition of her highly commendable efforts to make the world a better
12 place, Ms. Ladouceur has been named one of the top youth volunteers in Georgia for 2014
13 and has been named a distinguished finalist for the Nineteenth Annual Prudential Spirit of
14 Community Awards; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in addition to her nonprofit work with Love2Haiti, Ms. Ladouceur has been an
16 outstanding member of the Girl Scouts of Greater Atlanta and an exceptional addition to the
17 student body of McIntosh High School; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is also recognized that Ms. Ladouceur is a resident of Peachtree City and is
19 held in the highest regard by all who have the pleasure of meeting her.
