A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the memory of Frederick Doberson and expressing regret at his passing; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, news of the passing of Frederick Doberson is received with deep regret by this
4 body; and

5 WHEREAS, the life led by this distinguished gentleman rendered his name dear to the hearts
6 of his family, friends, and fellow citizens alike; and

7 WHEREAS, he was born November 13, 1924, and resided in Guyton, Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, he contributed greatly to the civic and religious affairs of his community,
9 including serving on the city planning and zoning boards; serving as grand marshal of the
10 annual city Christmas parade and festival; working with the City of Guyton, the Effingham
11 County Health Department and Recreation Department, and the Pilgrim Missionary Baptist
12 Association to construct the popular Pilgrim Walking Trail for cardiovascular health
13 improvements; obtaining a grant to restore and upgrade the Highland Park playground;
14 successfully raising funds to benefit Veteran's Park; and through numerous other gifts of his
15 time and many talents; and
