A RESOLUTION

1 Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that the Rules of the House
3 of Representatives are amended as follows:

4 SECTION 1.

5 The Rules of the House of Representatives are amended by revising Rule 56 as follows:

6 "**Rule 56.** All reports of a committee shall be in writing. All reports shall reflect the vote of
7 each member voting as well as each member abstaining on all motions made relating to the
8 legislation under consideration. The minority of a committee may make a report in writing,
9 setting forth succinctly the reasons for its dissent. Wherever practicable, each committee
10 shall include with its report on each general bill or resolution a brief resume of the bill. If
11 the committee shall so order, the Clerk shall have the majority report printed and distributed
12 to the members of the House. In order to be considered, a written minority report must be
13 filed with the Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on the next legislative day after the committee
14 report is filed. If a minority report is written, and a majority of the minority of the committee
15 shall so order, the Clerk shall have the minority report printed and distributed to members
16 of the House."
