#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Spelman College Class of 1969 in honor of its 45th  
2 reunion; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Class of 1969 included 235 young women who attended Spelman College  
4 in the Fall of 1965 and graduated in the Spring of 1969 during one of the most exciting and  
5 transformational times in American history, providing a ringside seat to people and events  
6 that changed the world; and

7 WHEREAS, the Class of 1969 soaked up all Spelman had to offer, fought for change inside  
8 and outside of the college, and graduated with degrees and determination ready to change the  
9 world; and

10 WHEREAS, because of the stellar education they obtained, the Class of 1969 now includes  
11 152 living and 21 deceased women who have led meaningful and accomplished lives as  
12 parents, educators, lawyers, ministers, Georgia governmental and local representatives,  
13 community leaders, entrepreneurs, and airline personnel; and

14 WHEREAS, the Spelman Class of 1969 proudly celebrates the friendships, opportunities,  
15 and support that its Spelman College sisterhood represents; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
17 remarkable group be appropriately recognized.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
19 recognize and commend the Spelman College Class of 1969 in honor of its 45th reunion and  
20 express their most sincere best wishes for continued success and happiness.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
22 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Spelman College Class of 1969.
