A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Jacob Allen; and for other purposes.

3 weight class State Championship wrestling title; and

4 WHEREAS, Jacob began wrestling in the fifth grade, following in the steps of his father,
5 who achieved fourth in state in Maryland; and

6 WHEREAS, upon entering high school, Jacob was coached by Joe Eichfeld, who helped him
7 develop his technique; and

8 WHEREAS, as a senior who qualified for the state championships, Jacob won his first three
9 matches, taking him to the finals; and

10 WHEREAS, through strong technique and determination, Jacob was the last wrestler
11 standing in his weight class, thereby securing the 195 pound State Championship title; and

12 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of this wrestler is a clear indication of his
13 outstanding athletic ability, his dedication and hard work, and his unity of purpose and spirit;

15 WHEREAS, as this athlete earned his well-deserved reputation for excellence by performing
16 with precision and dedication over months of training and competition, it is abundantly
