## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, so as to
- 2 abolish the Georgia Medical Center Authority; to provide for related matters; to provide an
- 3 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 5 SECTION 1.
- 6 Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, is amended by
- 7 repealing in its entirety Chapter 15, relating to the Georgia Medical Center Authority, and
- 8 designating said chapter as reserved.
- 9 SECTION 2.
- 10 As of the effective date of this Act, the Georgia Medical Center Authority is abolished and
- 11 shall cease to exist.
- SECTION 3.
- 13 (a) Any funds held by the Georgia Medical Center Authority as of the effective date of this
- 14 Act shall be paid to the state treasury and become a part of the general funds of the state.
- 15 (b) On the effective date of this Act, any outstanding contracts, licenses, and obligations of
- 16 the Georgia Medical Center Authority shall be transferred to the Board of Regents of the
- 17 University System of Georgia until the same are completed or extinguished.
- 18 SECTION 4.
- 19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- without such approval.
- 21 SECTION 5.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
