

ADOPTED

Senator Mckoon of the 29th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Education and Youth Committee substitute to HB 405 (LC 33 5604S) by*
2 *inserting after "training;" on line 4 the following:*

3 to amend Code Section 20-2-157 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to a
4 uniform reporting system for certain purposes and academic eligibility requirements to
5 receive a HOPE scholarship, so as to require local school systems to calculate and provide
6 a grade point average for freshman, sophomore, and junior students for purposes of
7 determining HOPE eligibility;

8 *By inserting between lines 38 and 39 the following:*

9 **SECTION 3A.**

10 Code Section 20-2-157 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to a uniform
11 reporting system for certain purposes and academic eligibility requirements to receive a
12 HOPE scholarship, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

13 "(g) At the conclusion of each school year, the local school system shall provide to each
14 freshman, sophomore, and junior student or to his or her parent or guardian the grade point
15 average calculated by the Georgia Student Finance Commission in accordance with the
16 provisions of this Code section for determining HOPE eligibility."
