A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Black Men Run; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Black Men Run is an organization that encourages distance running among its
3 membership and spreads awareness about the positive impact the sport has on issues like
4 hypertension, diabetes, and obesity; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the group has grown exponentially, and chapters have now been founded in 30
6 cities, including Atlanta, Georgia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, runs are held biweekly, with a robust fellowship that flourishes online
8 in-between each group activity; and
- 9 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
10 remarkable organization be appropriately recognized.
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
12 the members of this body recognize and commend Black Men Run for its efforts in raising
13 awareness about major health issues affecting African American men and express to the
14 organization their most sincere best wishes for continued success.
