## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Upsilon Alpha Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha  
2 Sorority, Inc.; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on January 29, 1994, 30 aspiring professional women chartered the Upsilon  
4 Alpha Omega Chapter in Lawrenceville, Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, Upsilon Alpha Omega was chartered by a group of women who gathered to  
6 implement and support the international programs of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., as  
7 they pertain to the needs of Gwinnett County; and

8 WHEREAS, thus far, the chapter has awarded more than \$150,000.00 in scholarships to  
9 college-bound women, contributed more than \$75,000.00 to the American Cancer Society,  
10 and donated more than \$15,000.00 to Heifer International; and

11 WHEREAS, Upsilon Alpha Omega interacts with the Gwinnett community through hosting  
12 business exchange mixers for small businesses, domestic violence awareness workshops, and  
13 several voter registration drives; and

14 WHEREAS, today, the chapter is the first Black Greek letter organization in Gwinnett  
15 County that has made a significant impact on the community; and

16 WHEREAS, this year, Upsilon Alpha Omega celebrates 20 years of "Service to Makind" in  
17 Gwinnett County; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the work of Upsilon Alpha Omega be  
19 appropriately recognized.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body recognize and commend the Upsilon Alpha Omega Chapter of  
22 Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., and express their most sincere best wishes for continued  
23 success.
