

ADOPTED

Senators Mullis of the 53rd and Unterman of the 45th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the House Committee on Budget & Fiscal Affairs Oversight substitute to SB 288 (LC*
 2 *33 5498S) by inserting after "reports" on line 5 the following:*

3 or meets certain conditions

4 *By striking the quotation mark at the end of line 28 and by adding after line 28 the following:*

5 (c) No high school which receives funding under this article shall participate in, sponsor,
 6 or provide coaching staff for interscholastic sports events which are conducted under the
 7 authority of, conducted under the rules of, or scheduled by any athletic association unless
 8 the athletic association:

9 (1) Requires that the members of its executive committee, board of trustees, or any
 10 associated boards are employed by a local school system or private school for a minimum
 11 of 100 school days per year; provided, however, that the executive committee:

12 (A) May include the State School Superintendent or his or her designee,
 13 representatives from associations representing local board of education members, local
 14 school superintendents, secondary school principals, athletic directors, and athletic
 15 coaches in this state;

16 (B) Shall include two female members appointed by such executive committee from
 17 nominees submitted by each region; and

18 (C) Shall authorize each member to vote on all matters pertaining to the operation of
 19 such athletic association;

20 (2) Limits the terms of members of its executive committee, board of trustees, or any
 21 associated boards to a total of four years;

22 (3) Provides that every school is allowed one vote to elect the executive director; and

23 (4) Annually publishes and provides to each member school a detailed financial report
 24 of its revenues and expenditures.

25 This subsection shall not apply to any athletic association which organizes, sanctions,
 26 schedules, and establishes regulations for interscholastic sports events which exclusively
 27 involve disabled athletes."
