A RESOLUTION

1 Encouraging the governing authority of Augusta-Richmond County to coordinate with the
2 legislative delegation to form the South Augusta Growth initiative; and for other purposes.

5 WHEREAS, now is the time for an efficient, coordinated plan to assist South Augusta in its
6 transformation into a modern, thriving community of the future, including such areas of

10 Fort Gordon's prominence in technology development, Augusta-Richmond County is now
11 on the cusp of becoming a center for skilled jobs.

13 the members of this body encourage the governing authority of Augusta-Richmond County
14 to coordinate with the legislative delegation to form the South Augusta Growth Initiative to
