A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Leete Hill United Methodist Church; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Leete Hill United Methodist Church was organized in 1920 by a group of
3 dedicated men who named the church after Mr. Hill, who donated the land, and Reverend
4 Leete, who was the first pastor; and
- 5 WHEREAS, after Reverend O'Neal served subsequently, also as an unofficial pastor, the
6 conference appointed Reverend A. D. McClendon officially; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in 1970, Reverend G. W. Ramson oversaw the transition of the church into a
8 new building; under Reverend W. E. Geter's pastorage, prayer services, Bible studies, and
9 church visiting increased; and under the leadership of Reverend John D. Tompkins, the
10 church began numerous beautification efforts and several new auxiliaries; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in 2004, the beloved Reverend Lenton Snow became the full-time pastor,
12 leading the church and community to great spiritual heights; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Leete Hill United Methodist Church has become a beacon of light and hope to
14 LaGrange, Georgia, through its 94 years of spiritual service to the community; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
16 remarkable church be appropriately recognized.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body recognize and commend Leete Hill United Methodist Church and
19 express their most sincere best wishes to the church for its continued spiritual growth and
20 success.
