A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Margaret Clisby Powell Flowers; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, as one of Thomasville's most beloved citizens, Margaret Clisby Powell Flowers
3 worked to promote education, cultivate a sense of history, and maintain the rich surroundings
4 of her home; and

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Flowers was a founding member of the Thomasville Cultural Center,
6 serving as one of the earliest presidents of its Board of Trustees; she also served as president
7 of the Thomas County Historical Society; and

8 WHEREAS, she was instrumental in the founding of Brookwood School in Thomasville and
9 served on its board of trustees; and

10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Flowers was named Thomas County's Woman of the Year in 1981, served
11 as the chairman of the Thomasville Town Committee of the National Society of the Colonial
12 Dames of America, and was an active member in the Rambler Rose Garden Club; and

13 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, she was an active member of First
14 Presbyterian Church and served as its first female deacon; and

15 WHEREAS, she was united in love and marriage to Langdon S. Flowers, and was blessed
16 with five remarkable children, 22 wonderful grandchildren, and four cherished
17 great-grandchildren; and

18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Flowers will always be remembered for her devotion to her family, fellow
19 citizens, and the City of Thomasville; and

20 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
21 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,
22 she made this world a better place in which to live.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Margaret Clisby Powell
25 Flowers.
