

Senate Resolution 415

ADOPTED

A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to prohibit the General Assembly from
2 increasing the maximum state income tax rate; to provide for submission of this amendment
3 for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

5 Article VII, Section III of the Constitution is amended by adding a new Paragraph to read as
6 follows:

7 "Paragraph IV. *Increase in state income tax rate prohibited.* The General Assembly
8 shall not increase the maximum marginal rate of the state income tax above that in effect
9 on January 1, 2015."

SECTION 2.

11 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
12 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
13 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

14 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended to prohibit the General
15 () NO Assembly from increasing the maximum state income tax rate?"

16 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
17 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
18 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
19 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
