A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Clint Hinton as the 2014 National Sporting Clays Association Junior National
2 Champion; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Clint Hinton was born and raised in Gwinnett County by his parents, David and
4 Kathy Hinton, both of whom are from the sixth generation of Gwinnett County families; and

5 WHEREAS, Clint began shooting at a very early age, and from the time he was old enough
6 to hold a gun, he went hunting with his Dad and his uncles which instilled a passion for the
7 sport; and

8 WHEREAS, since his first competition at the age of 13, Clint has won numerous titles,
9 including the 2014 National Sporting Clays Association Junior National Championship; and

10 WHEREAS, Clint also was picked by the National Rifle Association to be on the NRA "All
11 American" Shotgun Team for 2014; and

12 WHEREAS, Clint has been truly blessed with a talent for the shooting sport and received a
13 scholarship to attend Bethel University in McKenzie, Tennessee, where he has won many
14 collegiate titles as an individual and as a member of the shooting team; and

15 WHEREAS, Clint and the Bethel Team returned from shooting at the Scholastic Clay Target
16 Program (SCTP) Nationals where Clint won the title of High Over All Champion with a
17 score of 587 out of 600 while competing against 2,200 other shooters, and the team won the
18 SCTP National Championship for the second year in a row.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend Clint Hinton for his accomplishments in the shooting sport.
