A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Reverend Edward Moore; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Reverend Moore served in the United States Army for 20 years, until he retired
3 as a first sergeant, and, during this time, he was called to preach; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Reverend Moore is a Columbus native who graduated from Spencer High
5 School and earned his Bachelor's and Master's degrees from Troy University; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he has worked as a newspaper sales director, a salesman for the World Book
7 Encyclopedia, a teacher at Headstart, and a substitute teacher, where he saw the need for an
8 organization to help young men stay out of trouble; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he started an organization called My Brothers Keeper Ministries, Inc., which
10 aims to mentor young men and provide them with positive father figures from a select group
11 of men chosen by Reverend Moore; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Reverend Moore is visiting mothers in the Columbus area whose sons are at
13 risk in an attempt to get them into the program and to help them stay out of trouble; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Reverend Moore's work through My Brothers Keeper Ministries, Inc., will be
15 both a positive influence on the lives of the young men that he is mentoring as well as a help
16 to the Columbus community.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commend Reverend Edward Moore for his work through My Brothers Keeper Ministries,
19 Inc.
