A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Debbie Chrzanowski for being named one of the winners in round five of the
2 Innovation in Teaching Competition; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, five winners were announced in round five of the Innovation in Teaching
4 Competition, which is a recognition and reward opportunity for teachers who demonstrate
5 innovative teaching strategies for the Georgia standards in English/Language Arts and
6 Mathematics, and the fifth round focused on rewarding innovative secondary and special
7 education teachers; and

8 WHEREAS, principals, assistant principals, instructional coaches, and district staff
9 representing schools around this state nominated teachers for round five of the competition;

11 WHEREAS, each winning teacher will be recognized by the State of Georgia and the
12 teacher's school will receive a \$5,000.00 grant for implementation of Georgia's instructional
13 standards; and

14 WHEREAS, Debbie Chrzanowski, a kindergarten teacher at Baker Elementary School in the
15 Cobb County School District, was recognized for her superior performance by the state and
16 was named one of the winners in the fifth round of the Innovation in Teaching Competition.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commend Debbie Chrzanowski on her recent recognition as a winner of the Innovation in
19 Teaching Competition.
