#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Rabun County as the Farm to Table Capital of Georgia; and for other purposes.

- 4 WHEREAS, the diversity and variety of high-quality farms, mills, dairies, apiaries, ranches,  
5 and vineyards in Rabun County place it in the perfect position to claim the title of Farm to  
6 Table Capital of Georgia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, there is an unparalleled commitment from award-winning restaurants, chefs,  
8 schools, and the Northeast Georgia Food Bank to use the abundance of regionally grown  
9 products, creating a farm-to-table freshness unrivaled in this state; and
- 10 WHEREAS, agri-tourism and culinary tourism combined make one of the largest economic  
11 contributions to the Rabun County community; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the growing importance of Rabun County as an agricultural and culinary  
13 destination makes it fitting and proper to call Rabun County the Farm to Table Capital of  
14 Georgia.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
16 the members of this body recognize Rabun County as the Farm to Table Capital of Georgia.

18 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to  
19 representatives of Rabun County.
