7 and has 274 chapters nation-wide, with 15 chapters in Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, Links members contribute more than 500,000 documented community service
9 hours annually throughout the United States and the world; and

WHEREAS, two members of the Georgia General Assembly, Representative Carolyn
Hugley and Senator Freddie Powell Sims, are distinguished members of The Links,
Incorporated; and

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2015, members of The Links, Incorporated from across the
country will gather at their state capitols to encourage support of legislation and programs;
and

WHEREAS, Georgia chapters of The Links, Incorporated are championing Safe Harbor bills
which provide immunity to children who are victims of human trafficking, as well as
legislation which supports victims of domestic violence.
