A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Amanda Miliner, a former Miss Georgia, for her accomplishment of winning
2 the 2015 Georgia Teacher of the Year award and inviting her to be recognized by the House
3 of Representatives, and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, in 2006, Miliner was named Miss Georgia and, in 2008, she won the honor of
5 being named Miss Georgia USA; and

6 WHEREAS, Miliner later became a fourth-grade teacher at Miller Elementary School in
7 Houston County; and

8 WHEREAS, she has been named the 2015 Georgia Teacher of the Year and has been entered
9 into the National Teacher of the Year competition; and

10 WHEREAS, she has won gifts from such organizations as the Georgia Foundation for Public
11 Education and the Professional Association of Georgia Educators; and

12 WHEREAS, Miliner's work as a host teacher for a math early intervention program has
13 reaped noticeable benefits, among them the fact that her class has for several years had a 100
14 percent pass rate on the math portion of the Criterion-Referenced Competency Test; and

15 WHEREAS, as Georgia's Teacher of the Year, Miliner will travel the state to serve as an
16 ambassador for education.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body commend Amanda Miliner for being chosen as the 2015 Georgia
19 Teacher of the Year and invite her to be recognized by the House of Representatives at a date
20 and time to be determined by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
