A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February as Career and Technical Education Month and recognizing February
2 17, 2015, as Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations Day at the state capitol;
3 and for other purposes.

5 FBLA, FCCLA, FFA, HOSA, SkillsUSA, and TSA, and Career, Technical, and Agricultural
6 Education provide a solid establishment for the youth of America and the future of the

8 WHEREAS, the Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations promote occupational
9 excellence, leadership, and citizenship among their members, who are preparing for the
10 workforce and further education; and

11 WHEREAS, the Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations are an integral and
12 co-curricular component of the Career, Technical, and Agricultural Education programs
13 which are designed to support instructional objectives and attainment of academic and
14 technical competencies; and

15 WHEREAS, they provide an opportunity for students to gain confidence and knowledge
16 through competition; and

17 WHEREAS, the Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations motivate youth to
18 become better students and more productive citizens, which in turn develop school and
19 community leaders; and

20 WHEREAS, February is officially recognized as Career and Technical Education Month by
21 the Association for Career and Technical Education and the Georgia Association for Career
22 and Technical Education.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body recognize the month of February as Career and Technical
25 Education Month and recognize February 17, 2015, as Georgia Career and Technical Student
26 Organizations Day at the state capitol.
