A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of February 2-6, 2015, as National School Counseling Week; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, National School Counseling Week 2015, "Celebrate School Counseling," is
4 focusing public attention on the unique contributions school counselors make by helping
5 students to achieve success in school and plan for the future; and

6 WHEREAS, school counselors are employed in public and private schools to help students
7 reach their full potential; and

8 WHEREAS, school counselors are actively committed to helping students explore their
9 interests, abilities, strengths, and talents relating to development and career awareness; and

10 WHEREAS, school counselors help parents focus on ways to further the educational,
11 personal, and social growth of their children; and

12 WHEREAS, school counselors work with teachers and other educators to help students to
13 explore their potential and to set realistic goals for themselves; and

14 WHEREAS, school counselors seek to identify and utilize community resources that can
15 enhance and complement comprehensive school counseling programs to help students
16 become productive members of society; and

17 WHEREAS, comprehensive developmental school counseling programs are considered an
18 integral part of the educational process which enables all students to achieve success in
19 school.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 recognize the week of February 2-6, 2015, as National School Counseling Week.

24 Counselors Association.
