- WHEREAS, by 2016, the company will export between 15 and 20 containers of raw
 furniture materials to Saudi Arabia, allowing the same quality of solid oak furniture abroad;

- WHEREAS, the company partnered with United States Representative Doug Collins to makethe project possible.
